
1158 Munich was founded by Henry the Lion (June 14th) 1214 First mention of Munich as a city (civitas) in an official deed 1255 Munich becomes the roval seat of the House of Wittelsbach 1494 The Church of Our Lady. 







#### Employees in Munich subject to social insurance contributions at the place of work by sectors




