History

1158 1214 1255 1494	Munich was founded by Henry the Lion (June 14th) First mention of Munich as a city (civitas) in an official deed Munich becomes the royal seat of the House of Wittelsbach The Church of Our Lady, Munich's most famous landmark, is
1589 1789 1806 1810	consecrated The opening of Munich's Hofbräuhaus The English Garden is opened to the public Munich becomes the capital city of the Kingdom of Bavaria The first Oktoberfest (October 17th) held on the occasion of the marriage of Crown Prince Ludwig to Therese, Princess of Saxony
1818 1825 – 1848	Bavarian Constitution comes into force King Ludwig I – Munich becomes an internationally renowned city of culture
1839 1848 – 1864	The first railway travels between Munich and Augsburg (Sep. 1st) King Max II – Creation of the "Maximilian style" in architecture
1864 – 1886	King Ludwig II – Zenith of music and art handcraft
1901 1918	Population of Munich reaches 500,000 Kurt Eisner proclaims the "Bavarian Democratic and Socialist Republic" (Nov.7**)
1923 1933	The Hitler Putsch fails (Nov. 11 th) National Socialists seize power (March 9 th).
1939 1945	Attempt to assassinate Hitler in Bürgerbräu fails The Americans march into Munich, marking the end of World War II for the city (April 30th)
1957 1972	The population of Munich reaches one million (Dec. 15th) XXth Summer Olympic Games in Munich (August 26th – Sept. 11th)
1974 1983	World Football Championship International Horticultural Show is opened (April 28th).
1992 1998	The new Munich Airport is opened (May 17th) The new Exhibition and Trade Fair Centre is opened in Riem (Feb. 12th)
2002 2005	Pinakothek der Moderne is opened (Sept. 19 th). The Allianz Arena is opened (May 30 th)
2006 2006	Opening game of the FIFA World Cup TM (June 9") The Synagogue and Jewish Community Centre on Jakobsplatz are completed
2008 2010	Summer celebrations to mark the city's 850 th anniversary 200 th anniversary of the Octoberfest with the "Historische Wiesn"
2015	The Munich Documentation Centre for the history of National Socialism is opened (May 1st)
2015 2016	The population of Munich reaches 1.5 million (May 8th) 140th anniversary of the Munich tramway
2017	Groundbreaking ceremony for the 2^{nd} main line of the inter-urban railway (April $5^{\text{th}})$









Distribution of pupils attending general schools 2015/2016








